

CMYSA Ejected Participant Report

(This form is used for team officials and players)

Coach's Instructions

It is the responsibility of the coach or registered adult of the offending participant to provide an Ejected Participant Report to the referee at the end of the match and have the referee complete the top of the form. Failure to provide the referee with an Ejected Participant Form may extend the suspension.

Instructions to Referees

If you send a participant off, you are required to fill out the top of this form and return it to the coach of the offending participant, or a registered adult if you have sent off the coach. It is intended as a receipt for the pass confiscated by the referee at the time the participant has been sent off.

Caution (yellow card) Codes

C-1 is guilty of unsporting behavior

C-2 shows dissent by word or action

C-3 persistently infringes the Laws of the Game

C-4 delays the restart of play

C-5 fails to respect the required distance when play is restarted with a corner kick or free kick

C-6 enters or re-enters the field of play without the referee's permission

C-7 deliberately leaves the field of play without the referee's permission

Ejection (red card) Codes

E-1 is guilty of serious foul play

E-2 is guilty of violent conduct

E-3 spits at an opponent or any other person

E-4* denies an opponent a goal or an obvious goal-scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball
(this does not apply to a goalkeeper within their own penalty area)

E-5 denies an obvious goal-scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the player's goal by an offense punishable by a direct free kick or a penalty kick.

E-6 uses offensive, insulting or abusive language

E-7* receives a second caution in the same match

Adult Dismissal Code

D-1 irresponsible behavior (minimum two match suspension)

* E4 and E7 ejections are a single match suspension. All other ejections are a minimum two-match suspension. The CMYSA board may choose to increase a two-match suspension depending on the severity of the incident.

NOTE: For each subsequent ejection, suspensions double.

Coach's Instructions:

For the match(s) when a participant is serving his/her suspension, it is the responsibility of the coach of the ejected participant to provide this Ejected Participant Report to the referee prior to the start of the match for their signature indicating that the participant did not participate in the match. After the suspension has been served, contact Ken Dix (290-3834) or Elaine Dix (290-3831) to get the player's ID card back. The Ejected Participant Report may be used as a temporary card while the participant ID card makes its way back to you.

Instructions to Referees:

A coach or registered adult may present this card to you and ask that you sign it and date it indicating that the participant in question (a player or coach) is not participating in the match, and therefore serving one (1) match of the suspension

NOTE: The ejected participant does not need to be present at the match in order for the pink card to be signed by the referee.
